**The 9 commandments of
Jesus Christ and their
consequences**

In John 14 verse 21 Jesus said:

The person who has My commandments and keeps them is the one who [really] loves Me; and whoever [really] loves Me will be loved by My Father, and I will love him and reveal Myself to him [I will make Myself real to him].”

According to the above Bible passage, Jesus will not accept that you love Him when you only say with your mouth that you love Him but you do not bother to know and obey His commandments or rules.

According to the statements of Jesus in many parts of the Bible, this is the attitude of a hypocrite and not a true disciple.

In Isaiah 29 verse 13 the Bible says:

The Lord says:

“These people come near to me with their mouth and honor me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me. Their worship of me is based on merely human rules they have been taught.

In Ezekiel 33 verse 31 the Bible says:

My people come to you, as they usually do, and sit before you to hear your words, but they do not put them into practice. Their mouths speak of love, but their hearts are greedy for unjust gain.

In Mathew 15 verse 7 - 9 Jesus said:

You hypocrites! Isaiah was right when he prophesied about you:

““These people honor me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me. They worship me in vain; their teachings are merely human rules.

Entering heaven and becoming great in Heaven is not as simple as you may think. Entering Heaven and becoming great in Heaven is not as simple as just believing in Jesus and going to church everyday and serving in the house of God. You can have all of these qualities and still end up in hell fire or as least important in Heaven forever.

Jesus said in **Mathew 7 verse 13 to 14** that narrow is the gate that leads to eternal life and only a few find it.

When our loved ones die we always politely say they have gone to be with the Lord but is it really true everyone of your loved one who died have actually gone to be with the Lord?

If you are really interested in entering Heaven and becoming great in Heaven forever then you must do your best to obey all of the 9 commandments or rules of Jesus below.

Commandment 1. You must believe in the LORD JESUS that He is the Almighty God and that He is the only way to the Father and that He is your Lord and Saviour who came into this world to die for you to be saved from your sins. This account is in **John 3 verse 16 to 18** and many other parts of the bible.

Commandment 2. You must get baptized in water by immersion for you to be saved. However, if you genuinely didn't have the opportunity to be water baptized by immersion before death or rapture then surely you will be allowed into Heaven. But, if you had the opportunity to be water baptized and you refused to get baptized or you decided to ignore or think it is not important for your salvation to be complete, then you will not be allowed into Heaven. **Mark 16 verse 15 - 16**

It is not the absence of baptism that disqualifies you from entering Heaven but the despising of baptism that disqualifies you. That is, when you treat baptism as unnecessary for salvation.

Commandment 3. You must walk in the ways of Jesus and behave like Him to the end. In other words, you must do your best to behave like Jesus till you breathe your last breath because someone's name previously written in the book of life can still be removed.

In **Rev 3 verse 5** Jesus said

He who overcomes shall be clothed in white garments, and I will not blot out his name from the Book of Life; but I will confess his name before My Father and before His angels.

In **Ezekiel 18 verse 24**, Jesus spoke through prophet Ezekiel and he said:

“But if a righteous person turns from their righteousness and commits sin and does the same detestable things the wicked person does, will they live? None of the righteous things that person has done will be remembered. Because of the unfaithfulness they are guilty of and because of the sins they have committed, they will die.

In **Hebrews 10 verse 26 to 27** the bible says

If we deliberately keep on sinning after we have received the knowledge of the truth, no sacrifice for sins is left, but only a fearful expectation of judgment and of raging fire that will consume the enemies of God

In **Hebrews 12 verse 14** the bible says

Follow peace with all men, and holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord

Commandment 4. You must love one another because showing wickedness to people either in form of racism and discrimination; or wickedness in form of depriving them of their rights or of what they qualify for; or wickedness in form of murder; or becoming a scammer; or deliberately making people to suffer pain and shed tears; or wickedness because of your personal gain you deliberately keep people ignorant or you refuse to constantly remind them about what they need to do on earth in order for them to qualify to enter Heaven and become great in Heaven; or any other form of wickedness you show to people even as a believer in Christ will surely make you end up in hell fire forever.

In **John 13 verse 34 to 35** Jesus commanded us to love one another and he said

“So now I am giving you a new commandment: Love each other. Just as I have loved you, you should love each other. Your love for one another will prove to the world that you are my disciples.”

Not loving one another can land you in hell fire. Learn from the judgement given by Jesus to the wicked and lazy unprofitable servant in the parable of the Talents and the parable of the ten minas.

Even when you show wickedness to fellow believers in Christ then your soul will also be rejected by Jesus the day you die. This account is found in the words of Jesus himself in **Mathew 25 verse 42 to 46**.

In **Mathew 25 verse 42 to 46** Jesus said: For I was hungry, and you didn't feed me. I was thirsty, and you didn't give me a drink. I was a stranger, and you didn't invite me into your home. I was naked, and you didn't give me clothing. I was sick and in prison, and you didn't visit me.'

“Then they will reply, ‘Lord, when did we ever see you hungry or thirsty or a stranger or naked or sick or in prison, and not help you?’

“And he will answer, ‘I tell you the truth, when you refused to help the least of these my brothers and sisters, you were refusing to help me.’

“And they will go away into eternal punishment, but the righteous will go into eternal life.”

Commandment 5. You must not become a lukewarm believer in Christ, otherwise your soul will be rejected by Jesus the day you die. In **Revelation 3 verse 14 to 19** Jesus said that He will spit out lukewarm believers from his mouth.

According to the description of Jesus in that bible passage, to be lukewarm means to be spiritually useless to God. This is a believer in Christ who is only interested in coming to Church because of the miracle and blessings he wants to achieve here on earth and once he gets it you don't see him in Church and in any spiritual activity again because he believes that he has achieved his goal in serving God.

He has no interest in things that are of eternal value like soul winning and living a holy life.

Would you rather prefer to end up in hell fire with the devil? Become wise now while you are still breathing.

Commandment 6. You must not **deliberately** disobey the soul winning commandment of Jesus Christ. In **Mark 16 verse 15 – 16, John 15 verse 16** and in many other parts of the Bible which includes the parable of the talents and the parable of the 10 minas, Jesus gave us His commandment to win souls as well as to ensure that our souls actually eventually make it to Heaven.

If because of your own personal gain and satisfaction you **deliberately** decide not to be profitable to the King of Heaven in terms of winning souls then your soul will be rejected by Jesus the day you die.

Learn from the parable of the talents and the parable of the ten minas that Jesus warned us about; how one of the servants **deliberately** decided to disobey the commandment of the Master to be profitable to God, instead he chose to hide his talent and went his way to do his own pleasure.

When the Master came back and saw that this servant made this deliberate decision, He called him a wicked and lazy servant and then sent him to hell fire.

But if you choose to focus on winning souls and ensure that your souls actually eventually enter Heaven, then you will not only qualify to enter Heaven but you will end up as a great person in Heaven forever. You may even end up as a Governor in Heaven as promised by Jesus in the parable of the 10 minas.

According to the parable of the talents, the parable of the 10 minas and the parable of the workers in the vineyard, your level of greatness in Heaven will be determined by how profitable you were to God on earth in terms of how many souls came into Heaven through you.

However, in the event that you did not deliberately neglect to obey the commandment of Jesus to be profitable to God in terms of winning souls; as long as it was due to reasons acceptable to God, you failed to fulfill this commandment of Jesus then according to **1st Corinthians 3 verse 13 – 15** and **Mathew 5 verse 19**, you will still be allowed into Heaven but only as someone who has barely escaped through fire; although you will lose your reward or end up as least important in Heaven forever.

Commandment 7: You must never **deliberately** decide to ignore the commandment of Jesus to constantly preach the true Gospel and focus on preaching the other gospels, otherwise your soul will be rejected by Jesus the day you die.

Learn from the parable of the talents and the parable of the ten minas that Jesus warned us about; how one of the servants **deliberately** decided to disobey the commandment of the Master, instead he chose to hide his talent and went his way to do his own pleasure.

When the Master came back and saw that this servant made this deliberate decision, He called him a wicked and lazy servant and then sent him to hell fire.

But if you choose to focus on constantly preaching the true Gospel to everyone then you will not only qualify to enter Heaven but you will end up with a great reward in Heaven for your obedience to God.

However, in the event that you did not **deliberately** neglect to obey the commandment of Jesus to constantly preach the true Gospel; as long as it was due to reasons acceptable to God, you failed to fulfill this commandment of Jesus then according to **1st Corinthians 3 verse 13 – 15** and **Mathew 5 verse 19**, you will still be allowed into Heaven but only as someone who has barely escaped through fire; although you will lose your reward or end up as least important in Heaven forever.

Commandment 8. You must never call Jesus a scammer or thief because if you do then your soul will be rejected by Jesus the day you die. Calling the Church of God or the Bible a scam also means you are calling Jesus a scam.

Learn from the parable of the talents and the parable of the 10 minas, the servant that deliberately decided not to be profitable to God called Jesus a scammer or a thief because he said to Jesus that I buried my talent because I know that you are a hard man who likes to reap from where you have not sown. Surely, this is the attitude of a scammer or a criminal.

Are there not people who call Jesus a scam today? Surely there are so many people who believe that following Jesus is a scam and that there is nothing like Jesus, there is nothing like Heaven and there is nothing like hell fire.

However, I make bold to tell you that it doesn't matter now whether you believe in the reality of Jesus and Heaven, hell fire, soul winning and everything written in the Bible because the day you die and get into eternity, you will surely believe but by then you will not have another opportunity to come back and make amends.

In the parable of the talents and in the parable of the ten minas, Jesus clearly warned us not to call Him a scammer. So, why not become wise now while you are still breathing?

Commandment 9. You must never deny Jesus after you have accepted Him as your Lord and Saviour. Even at the point of death or extreme suffering you must never deny Jesus otherwise He will reject your soul the day you die.

In **Mathew 10 verse 33** Jesus said

But whosoever shall deny Me before men, him will I also deny before My Father who is in Heaven.

In **Revelation 2 verse 10** Jesus said

Fear none of those things which thou shalt suffer: behold, the devil shall cast some of you into prison, that ye may be tried; and ye shall have tribulation ten days: be thou faithful unto death, and I will give thee a crown of life.

If you would like to accept Jesus Christ as your Lord and Saviour, say this prayer with me from your heart:

Lord Jesus, I come to you today just as I am. I acknowledge that I am a sinner. I am sorry for living my life against your commandments and now I have decided to repent.

Please forgive me from all my sins, wash me clean with your precious blood and save my soul because I don't want to go to hell fire. I accept you now into my heart as my Lord and Personal Saviour.

Write my name in the Book of Life and may it please you that when you come to collect your people, I will not be left aside. Give me the grace to live righteous and holy to the end of my days. Thank you, Lord Jesus, for saving my soul, amen.
