**Frequently Asked Questions  
about Eternal Life**

---

Ultimately, Jesus is the final Judge but we shall answer correctly from scripture the following frequently asked questions about eternal life.

**Question 1:** Will I be allowed into Heaven if I believe in Jesus and I do my best to obey His commandments but there are some sins that I am struggling to overcome?

**The answer is Yes,** you will still be allowed into Heaven as long as you are not deliberately living in sin and each time you sin you feel bad and your heart keeps asking God to take away the sin weakness from you. Ultimately, God knows your heart and how genuine you are in your walk with Him. **Hebrews 10 verse 26, 1<sup>st</sup> Samuel 16 verse 7.**

In **Psalms 51 verse 17** the bible says: The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit; a broken and a contrite heart, O God, Thou wilt not despise.

**Question 2:** Will I be allowed into Heaven if I believe in Jesus and I do my best to obey His commandments but I am not Baptized in water by immersion before death or rapture?

**The answer is Yes but** only if you genuinely didn't have the opportunity to be water baptized by immersion. However, if you had the opportunity to be water baptized and you refused to get baptized or you decided to ignore or think it is not important for your salvation to be complete, then you will not be allowed into Heaven. **Mark 16 verse 15 - 16**

It is not the absence of baptism that disqualifies you from entering Heaven but the despising of baptism that disqualifies you. That is, when you treat baptism as unnecessary for salvation.

**Question 3:** Will I be allowed into Heaven if I believe in Jesus and I do my best to obey His commandments but I wasn't profitable to God on earth in terms of soul winning?

**The answer is Yes, but** as long as you did not deliberately decide to disregard the command of Jesus to win souls because of your own personal gain. Any deliberate decision to disregard the command of Jesus to win souls because of your own personal gain will make you end up in hell fire. This is what the parable of the talents and the parable of the 10 minas teaches us .

Nevertheless, if you do not have any soul to give to God on judgment day due to reasons acceptable to God, then you will be allowed into Heaven but only as someone who has barely escaped through fire and you will lose your reward or end up as least important in Heaven forever. **1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians 3 verse 13 – 15** and **Mathew 5 verse 19** are some of the scriptures that attest to the validity of this answer.

**Question 4:** What is the true Gospel all about?

**Answer:** The true Gospel is the Gospel of the Kingdom of Heaven. This is the message that Jesus Himself brought to mankind.

The true Gospel is all about the following 3 messages of Christ:

1. How to qualify to enter Heaven based on the commandments of Jesus.
2. How to become great even as a Governor in Heaven forever based on the commandments of Jesus.
3. The eternal promises of the King of Heaven to those who will qualify to enter Heaven.

**Question 5:** Will I be allowed into Heaven if I believe in Jesus and I do my best to obey His commandments but I didn't preach the true Gospel of the Kingdom of Heaven message at all?

**The answer is Yes, but** as long as you did not deliberately decide to disregard the command of Jesus to preach the true Gospel because of your own personal gain. Any deliberate decision to disregard the command of Jesus to preach the true Gospel because of your own personal gain will make you end up in hell fire. This is what the parable of the talents and the parable of the 10 minas teaches us .

Nevertheless, if you did not preach the true Gospel due to reasons acceptable to God, then you will be allowed into Heaven but only as someone who has barely escaped through fire and you will lose your reward or end up as least important in Heaven forever. **1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians 3 verse 13 – 15** and **Mathew 5 verse 19** are some of the scriptures that attest to the validity of this answer.

**Question 6:** Will I be allowed into Heaven if I believe in Jesus and I do my best to obey His commandments but I am struggling with some besetting sins yet I am always conscious of showing mercy to people?

**The answer is Yes but** as long as those besetting sins are not deliberate acts and your heart cries out to God often to help you overcome those besetting sins.

Jesus promised to show mercy to the merciful.

**Mathew 5 verse 7**

**Question 7:** Will I be allowed into Heaven if due to extreme suffering or at the face of death I decided to stop believing in the reality of Jesus Christ?

**The answer is No.** Jesus commanded you never to deny Him even at the point of death otherwise He would reject your soul the day you die.

**Revelation 2 verse 10 , Mathew 10 verse 33.**

**Question 8:** Will I be allowed into Heaven if I am lukewarm and my reason for being a Christian is only to benefit from the miracles and blessings of God on earth?

**The answer is No.** Jesus warned you to avoid being lukewarm and having this kind of attitude towards God otherwise He would reject your soul the day you die.

To be lukewarm means to be spiritually useless to God which means to be unserious about spiritual activities like soul winning and living a holy life; rather you are only interested in the miracles and blessings of God on earth.

**Revelation 3 verse 14 - 19**

**Question 9:** Will I be allowed into Heaven if I believe in Jesus but I have a wicked heart and showed wickedness to people?

**The answer is No.** Remember that the heart of man is what God looks at and not the outward appearance as a Christian. This is what the bible says in **1<sup>st</sup> Samuel 16 verse 7**. If your heart is not right with God then you will not be allowed into Heaven. Jesus said in **Mathew 25 verse 42 – 46** and in many other parts of the Bible that the eternal destination of those with a wicked heart is hell fire.

**Question 10:** Will I be allowed into Heaven if I do not believe in the Bible as the true word of God?

**The answer is No.** Not believing in the Bible as the true word of God is tantamount to not believing in the reality of Jesus Christ.

**Question 11:** Will I be allowed into Heaven if I believe in God but I do not believe in Jesus?

**The answer is No.** In **James 2 verse 19** the bible says that even the demons believe in God. The bible is clear in **John 3 verse 16 – 18** that you must believe in Jesus Christ the begotten son of God for you to be saved. In **Revelation 1 verse 8** Jesus clearly said that He is the Almighty.

**Question 12:** What is God's acceptable way to prove to Him that I truly love Him with all my heart?

**The answer is when you are very serious about knowing and obeying all His commandments.** Jesus will not accept that you love Him when you only say with your mouth that you love Him but you do not bother to know and obey His commandments or rules. According to the statements of Jesus in **John 14 verse 21** and in many other parts of the Bible, this is the attitude of a hypocrite and not a true disciple.

**Question 13:** Can I ever lose my salvation?

**The answer is Yes.** Many parts of the Bible attests to the fact that your salvation can be lost. Jesus said in **Mathew 24 verse 13** that it is only those who shall endure to the end that will be saved. Jesus also said in **Revelation 3 verse 5** that He will not blot out from the book of life the names of those who shall endure to the end; which means that someone's name previously written in the book of life can still be removed by Jesus. Other scriptures include but not limited to the following: **Hebrews 10 verse 26, Ezekiel 18 verse 24, Mathew 25 verse 42 – 46, 1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians 9 verse 27, Mathew 3 verse 8 AMP Bible Version.**

The best way to interpret scripture is to do a wholistic analogy of the statements said about that subject matter before making any wise and logical conclusion.

For example, you may find someone in the Bible making a statement in a certain context but then later on find the same person or someone else making a further statement about that subject matter. In this case, you must add the primary and further statements together to arrive at the most accurate conclusion of that subject matter.

So, if Jesus once said that you will be saved if you believe in Him but later on said that your name can still be removed from the book of life if you do not endure to the end, then you should simply come to a conclusion that salvation requires both believing in Jesus AND walking in the character of Christ to the end.

**Question 14:** Can God use me to perform miracles and prophesy and yet send me to hell fire?

**The answer is Yes.** God used Moses to perform many powerful miracles and to prophesy but still punished him and Aaron by making sure they never enter the promised land due to Moses disobedience of striking the rock twice instead of speaking to the rock for water to come out as instructed by God. This account is found in **Numbers 20 verse 11 - 12.**

Jesus also said In **Mathew 7 verse 21 – 23** that He will reject many miracle and prophetic servants of God on judgment day.

**Question 15:** Does being able to perform miracles and prosper financially prove that God is happy with me?

**The answer is No.** Being able to perform miracles and prosper financially are not Biblical proofs of God's validation of someone. Take a lesson from the answer to question 14 above.

**Question 16:** What is soul winning and how is it different from evangelism?

**Answer:** Evangelism means the spreading of the true Gospel either online or offline while Soul winning means the act of making sure that those who decide to repent and follow Jesus actually follow Him to their death or rapture. Soul winning is all about discipleship and discipleship means constantly reminding the soul about the true Gospel so that they are constantly in hopes of the glory and wealth waiting for them in Heaven if they obey the commandments of Jesus to the end.

**Question 17:** Will I still be rewarded in Heaven if I lead someone to Christ but that person eventually did not make it to Heaven?

**The answer is No.** A wise Soul winner understands that he only gets paid in eternity for the soul that actually enter Heaven through him. A wise soul winner will not give his soul to any church or Pastor that does not know the details of the true Gospel or that is not serious about constantly preaching the true Gospel. Constantly reminding your souls about the true Gospel by constantly reminding them to listen to our online videos about eternity, is a good soul winning strategy.

**Question 18: Is there Government in Heaven?**

**The answer is Yes.** The bible says in **Isaiah 9 verse 7a** that: Of the increase of **His Government** and peace there shall be no end. In **Luke 19 verse 16 - 19** Message bible version, Jesus promised soul winners to give them positions as **Governors in Heaven.**

**Question 19:** Are there cities in Heaven and people that will rule over the cities as Governors?

**The answer is Yes.** In the parable of the 10 minas, Jesus clearly said that soul winners will be given authority over cities in Heaven.

**Luke 19 verse 16 – 19 Message Bible Version.**

**Question 20:** Is there seniority in Heaven and are there people who are least important in Heaven?

**The answer is Yes.** Everyone in Heaven is not of the same position. In **Mathew 5 verse 19**, Jesus talks about some people ending up as least and others ending up in Heaven as great. In **Mathew 11 verse 11** Jesus said: The truth is that John the Baptizer is greater than anyone who has ever come into this world. But even **the least important person** in God's kingdom is greater than John.

**Question 21:** Will becoming a least important person in Heaven be satisfactory to me forever?

**The answer is Maybe, Maybe not.** Ending up as least important in Heaven forever may not be a good feeling. Jesus wants us to achieve more than just entering Heaven hence He dedicated **three parables to soul winning as it relates to eternal reward**. He also made many non parabolic statements in the Bible about soul winning as it relates to eternal reward; in the bid to emphasize on its eternal importance to us.

Please do not gamble with your eternal position and glory because there is no record in the Bible of promotion in Heaven. So, we can say that whatever you qualify to become in Heaven is what you shall remain as forever.

**Question 22:** Is it ever possible than I can go to hell fire while the souls I won to Christ go to Heaven?

**The answer is Yes.** If during your lifetime on earth you preached the true Gospel and won souls for Christ but you stopped believing in Jesus or did things worthy of disqualifying you from entering Heaven then you will not be allowed into Heaven. Jesus made it clear to us many times in the Bible that it is only those who shall endure to the end that shall be saved. **Mathew 24 verse 13, Revelation 3 verse 5**

In **1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians 9 verse 27** Apostle Paul said:

But I keep control of my body, and bring it into subjection, lest that by any means, when I have preached to others, I myself should be a castaway.

**Question 23:** Is it true that no matter how many times some people hear the true Gospel they will never repent because they are already lost?

**The answer is Yes.** In **2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians 4 verse 3 – 4** the Bible says:

But if our Gospel be hid, it is hid to those who are **lost**, whose unbelieving minds the god of this world hath blinded, lest the light of the glorious Gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them.

As a wise soul winner, you should not continue to chase after someone or a group of people who are adamant towards believing and obeying the true Gospel because you may end up wasting your time or even get beaten up or arrested or maimed.

You can still be very profitable to God without getting into trouble; and the way to do it is by channeling your energy and time more to those who joyfully receive you and receive the gospel because the Bible has clearly mentioned that there are people who are already lost.

In **Mathew 10 verse 14 – 17** Jesus said:

Whoever shall not receive you nor hear your words when you depart out of that house or city shake off the dust of your feet. Verily I say unto you, it shall be more tolerant for the land of Sodom and Gomorrah on the day of judgement, than for that city.

Behold, I send you forth as sheep in the midst of wolves. Be ye therefore wise as serpents and harmless as doves.

So, as you go out to win souls, be wise and bear in mind that there are many people whose final eternal destination is not Heaven. In **Mathew 7 verse 14**, Jesus said: **Few** are they that will find the way to eternal life.

This is **NOT TO SAY** that only 144,000 people have been chosen to enter Heaven as proclaimed by some religious movement. Apostle John in the same **Revelation 7 verse 5 -10** that they quote from, said that he saw a great and enormous crowd beyond the 144,000 people who were allowed to enter into Heaven.

**Question 24:** Will I still be given the reward for soul winning if I did not preach the true Gospel but after preaching the gospel of prosperity and healing, I made an altar call and the souls I led to Christ eventually enter Heaven?

**The answer is Yes, but** it is risky to lead people to Christ through the preaching of the other gospels because, their decision to repent may be because of the prosperity and miracles they seek from God after listening to your message, and not because of a concern about their eternal life.

Ignoring the recommended strategy of God for winning souls which is the preaching of the true Gospel, puts you at risk of getting little or no eternal reward due to only a small number, or none of the souls making it to Heaven eventually.

**Question 25:** What is the greatest eternal reward in Heaven?

**The answer is the reward for soul winning.** According to the statements of Jesus in the parable of the talents, the parable of the 10 minas, the parable of the workers in the vineyard and in many other parts of the Bible, we shall be given reward for everything we did on earth to advance the Kingdom of God, but the soul winners will receive the greatest kind of eternal reward in Heaven.

The soul winners are the actual Kingdom business partners of the Kingdom of God and according to **Luke 16 verse 16 – 19** (Message Bible Version), some of them will qualify to rule over cities in Heaven as Governors.

**Question 26:** What must I do in order for Jesus to say to me thou good and faithful servant on the day of judgment?

**The answer is** you must do your best to obey all the commandments of Jesus exactly as written in the Bible, especially the preaching of the true Gospel and the soul winning commandments of Jesus Christ.

It is very important to note that obeying the commandments of Jesus exactly how He instructed in the Bible is the key to receiving a praise reception from Him on that day.

In the parable of the talents and the parable of the ten minas, when the Master came back from His journey and saw that the two servants have obeyed His instruction exactly how He commanded them, he called them good and faithful servants and then gave them their eternal reward of Governorship positions in Heaven forever.

So do not expect a commendation from Jesus if whilst you were on earth you did not obey the commandments of Jesus according to His instructions in the Bible.

**Question 27:** What is the goal of the assignment of preaching the Gospel of the Kingdom of Heaven according to Mathew 24 verse 14?

**Answer:** The goal of the assignment of preaching the Goodnews of the Kingdom of Heaven is all about spreading it as a testimony to all nations. As a testimony means as a witness or as a testament. So that no nation can claim an excuse on the day of judgment that they didn't hear the true Gospel.

God may not be waiting for the true Gospel to reach the ears of every human being or every family or every city before He ends this world; because it may not be possible for every single person or family or city to hear the true Gospel.

So, the instruction of Jesus is that every Nation of the world should hear the true Gospel before He would be happy to end this world.

The assignment of preaching the true Gospel to all nations is not about using abusive words and actions on people as a way of communicating the truth to them. It is also not about cajoling or forcing people to believe and accept the Gospel.

If they choose not to believe and obey the Gospel, it should not bother you because delivering the message to them is where your assignment of preaching the Gospel ends.

You will receive the eternal reward for obeying the command of Jesus to go and preach the Gospel. The eternal reward for preaching the Gospel is all that should matter to you; and this eternal reward should be your only motivation for preaching the Gospel of the Kingdom of Heaven. This is what Jesus was talking about in **Mathew 24 verse 14** and in **Mathew 10 verse 14 – 15**.

Lord Jesus, I come to you today just as I am. I acknowledge that I am a sinner. I am sorry for living my life against your commandments and now I have decided to repent.

Write my name in the Book of Life and may it please you that when you come to collect your people, I will not be left aside. Give me the grace to live righteous and holy to the end of my days. Thank you, Lord Jesus, for saving my soul, amen.
